OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES IN 2016-2018

- Combat corruption in the public sector
- Build intolerance on the part of the society towards corruption
- Participate in the work of the Working Group on Bribery of the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), seeking full membership in the Working Group, and joining the OECD Convention on Combating Bribery of Foreign Public Officials in International Business Transactions.

For the purpose of developing the activities of the Service according to the defined areas of priorities in the course of 2016 we specifically focused on energy and infrastructure projects of strategic importance for the State, waste management, building renovation (modernisation); administration of international assistance, sale of land and restitution of ownership rights, healthcare and law enforcement. Furthermore, we have been consistently continuing our work in disclosing complex, pervasive corruption offences not infrequently related to political corruption.

FINANCING

- We have reached a 51% higher average of investigated criminal activities and the suspects within a single pre-trial investigation.
- We detected by 45% more serious crimes to public service and public interests.
- We took to court the cases in which 66% of the defendants were holding managerial positions.
- In 74% of the cases heard in courts the defendants were found guilty.
- Increase by 60% in the number of fines imposed by courts.

CRIMINAL PROSECUTION FOR CRIMINAL OFFENCES

- At our own initiative, we assessed 72% of analyzed legal acts and their drafts.
- We assessed from the anticorruption view point total 79 unique public procedures, and 40 unique areas of activities of public and municipal authorities.
- We drafted two handbooks on creating anti-corruption environment – for the private and the public sector.
- According to the Law on Prevention of Corruption we assessed by 61% more persons in respect of which a written application to the STT is not mandatory.

PREVENTION OF CORRUPTION

- We have been coordinating the sectoral anti-corruption education provided by other institutions.
- Targeted anti-corruption education to an audience of more than 9,000.
- Presented the anti-corruption education means for the youth: a comics booklet, and 5 commercials.
- Provided a possibility to readily report identified corruption cases using a mobile app *Pranešk STT*.
- As few as 5% of corporate managers, and by 2.8 times fewer civil servants admitted having given bribes within the last 12 months.
